## CASA VOLUNTEERS ... GIVING THEIR HEART AND SOUL TO HELP A CHILD WHO HAS BEEN ABUSED AND NEGLECTED!

Through July 31, CASA volunteer Guardians ad Litem (GALs) worked one-on-one with 616 child victims of abuse and neglect from 307 families in Franklin County. Together, these compassionate volunteers have already given over 7,600 volunteers hours helping the children assigned them by the Franklin County courts!



However, of the 247 current active CASA volunteers, just 37 are male – and only 55 of the total volunteers are people of color. The need is especially high for more men of diverse backgrounds to work with boys of all ages who have been abused and neglected.

If you are an employee of one of the organizations listed above, you can make a one-time donation or ongoing payroll deduction on behalf of Friends as shown below:

- State of Ohio Campaign dates Aug. 22 Oct. 20 ... Employees can access the ePledge site by signing into myOhio.gov and then clicking on myCCC.
- The Ohio State University Buckeyes for Charity Campaign dates Sept. 18 Nov. 3 ... Click the <u>online Giving</u> Link. Use your OSU NAME.# and password to access and click Pledge Now to begin the process
- Franklin County Campaign dates Sept. 11 Nov. 3 ... Ask your supervisor or HR office how to give.
- The City of Columbus Campaign dates Oct. 2 Nov. 9 ... Ask your supervisor or HR office how to give.
