A CASA Volunteer:

- Must be at least 21 years of age
- Must successfully pass a screening process and background check
- Receives 45 hours of initial training
- Must attend 12 hours of inservice training each year
- Serves an average of 10-15 hours per month

Through May 31, 2022, 468 children from 238 family units have been served by volunteer GALS this year – and there are currently 322 active volunteers.
