Did you know? There is no typical profile of a <u>Court Appointed Special Advocate</u>. CASA volunteers come from all walks of life, with a variety of professional, educational and ethnic backgrounds. They are male and female adults who are employed, retired, at-home parents, or full-time volunteers. At this time, adult males make up just 20% of the 265 current active volunteer Guardians ad Litem (GALs) at CASA of Franklin County, Ohio – and more male volunteers are welcome and needed!

Through September 30, CASA GALs have worked with **588 children from 298 family units**. Also in September, seven new volunteer Guardians ad Litem were sworn in by Franklin County Magistrate Terrence Scott. Welcome to these new GALs – and we thank all GALs for their commitment to helping abused and neglected children.

Friends thanks the Harry C. Moores Foundation for a \$15,000 grant awarded in September. These funds will be used for the development and implementation of a new specialized training program that will enhance knowledge and skills of GALs specific to additional emotional turmoil abused and neglected children are experiencing post-pandemic. This turmoil can be manifesting largely because of adults in the family who abuse alcohol and other drugs and may be worsened among children who lost a parent or other family member to drug overdose.

There were 55 CASA staff, volunteers and Friends board members who attended the Ohio CASA 2022 Celebrate Kids! Conference in Columbus last month. Friends is proud to have provided scholarships for 18 CASA volunteers so they could attend the three-day conference.





Friends also participated in an employee volunteer fair organized by Huntington Bank for employees to learn about volunteer opportunities here in Columbus.
